Thesis Advisor Selection Rules

Amendment Approved at the 100th Academic Affairs Council Meeting on June 11th, 2004

- 1. Thesis Advisor Selection Rules (the Rules) are established to be the foundation of thesis advisor selection for each department/collage in National Sun Yat-sen University (NSYSU).
- 2. A thesis advisor must be an assistant professor or above, as well as qualified of being a master's examination committee member in accordance with the Degree Conferral Law.
- A thesis advisor should be selected within the student's department/college. However, if the
 department/college lack related research area or suitable teacher, the student could select advisor
 from outside of the department/college in NSYSU.
 - If unable to select thesis advisor from NSYSU, the student could select professor or expert from outside of the university, while arranging another NSYSU faculty as co-advisor.
- 4. The thesis advisor, after retiring or resigning from the university, may continue advising the student. However, the student must arrange another NSYSU faculty as co-advisor.
- 5. The student in within 3 years newly established department/college could select thesis advisors from outside of the university, owing to insufficient of teachers, without being restrained by Article 3, Paragraph 2 of the Rules.
- 6. Except the department/college provide more stringent rules, the Rules are the principle regarding to thesis advisor selection
- 7. The Rules are implemented after approved by Academic Affairs Council meeting. Therefore, the amendment of the Rules must follow suit.
